


MESSAGE FROM THE SENIOR MINISTER

PIEDMONT COMMUNITY CHURCH MISSION PROJECTS



SUPPORT ORPHANS IN MALAWI

KAFITA FOOD BANK & BENEVOLENCE FUND - On a weekly basis, there are as many as 100 families that attend Kafita - or live in the surrounding villages - that go without food and basic necessities. This fund provides them with life-sustaining food.

SUPPLIES FOR BLIND CHILDREN IN MALAWI, AFRICA

CHILANGA SCHOOL FOR THE BLIND, MALAWI - To be a blind orphan is devastating, but albino children are especially vulnerable in Africa. They are ostracized, and sometimes killed since, according to folklore, their skin has magical power. The Chilanga School for the Blind provides shelter, food and education to blind children in Malawi.

GLOBAL COMMUNITY SUPPORT



RESCUE SLAVERY VICTIMS

Piedmont Church Mission Partner - INTERNATIONAL JUSTICE MISSION (IJM) is the largest anti-slavery organization in the world. Teams of investigators, lawyers and social workers work to rescue victims, restore survivors, bring criminals to justice and strengthen systems.

BUILD PROTECTED WELLS

Piedmont Church Mission Partner - MARION MEDICAL MISSION - Builds protected wells in villages throughout rural Africa, providing access to clean drinking water. This is a crucial resource, promoting health and hygiene and shortening the distance families must travel to get water. Note: Photo above is of a well installed in 2001, but taken this year, 2019 - a tribute to the sustainability of the well program.

\$45 Buys a share of a protected well \$450 Installs a whole protected shallow well for a village



SUPPORT MEDICAL CARE IN MALAWI, HAITI

Piedmont Church Mission Partner - **MEDICAL BENEVOLENCE FOUNDATION (MBF)** is committed to improving medical care around the world. In Malawi, MBF strives to manage chronic illnesses, prevent blindness and reduce the mortality rates for mothers and their babies. In Haiti, there are only 11 nurses for every 100,000 people. MBF educates nurses so that they can practice health care within their own home communities, fulfilling the desperate need for health care throughout all of Haiti.

PREVENT BLINDNESS

Piedmont Church Mission Partner – **SEVA FOUNDATION**. Since 1978, Seva has provided sight-saving surgeries, eyeglasses, medicine, and other eye care services to more than 40 million people in underserved communities. You can free someone from blindness for only \$50.

CREATE SMALL BUSINESSES TO LIFT FAMILIES OUT OF POVERTY

Piedmont Church Mission Partner - VILLAGE ENTERPRISE - By combining group-based business creation, financial literacy training, ongoing mentoring and access to savings groups, Village Enterprise provides participants with a sustainable path out of extreme poverty. Our entrepreneurs, 76% of them women, are able to provide better nutrition for their families, send their children to school, build household savings for the first time and improve their living conditions.

ATTACK POVERTY AND INJUSTICE

Piedmont Church Mission Partner - **WORLD VISION** - Since the end of World War II, World Vision has been one of the leading Christian agencies sponsoring children in poor countries and tackling the causes of poverty and injustice.

HELP A CHILD RISE ABOVE POVERTY & EDUCATIONAL INEQUITY

Piedmont Church Mission Partner – **CHILDREN RISING** (formerly Faith Network) is an Oakland nonprofit partnering with severely under resourced Oakland public schools to provide life changing, one-on-one reading and math tutoring for 2nd grade children not able to read or count - and struggling to not fall further behind in school. Church volunteers have tutored these children for more than 13 years at various elementary schools in Oakland.

IGNITE HOPE FOR OAKLAND'S HUNGRY AND HOMELESS

Piedmont Church Mission Partner - CITYTEAM, OAKLAND - CityTeam Oakland shares Christ's unconditional and redemptive love by caring for immediate needs and enabling lasting solutions for families struggling with food insecurity, lack of stable shelter, and addiction.

\$10 Provides 5 meals for a homeless adult or child \$40 Provides a food box for a family



NEW DAY FOR CHILDREN

Piedmont Church Mission Partner - **NEW DAY FOR CHILDREN** is a faith-based 501(c)(3) working to provide hope and help to families of sex trafficked children in the Bay Area. Hope is given as they learn they are not alone and that there is a safe haven. New Day provides the financial and community support needed for care and healing. We work with law enforcement, other faith based and community organizations and families to support the needs of American girls, ages 10 to 18, suffering from the trauma of human trafficking.

HELP FOSTER KIDS TRANSITION TO LIVING INDEPENDENTLY

Piedmont Church Mission Partner - **FIRST PLACE FOR YOUTH** helps foster youth build the skills they need to make a successful transition to self-sufficiency and responsible adulthood. We provide housing and education and employment support in Alameda, Santa Clara, San Francisco, Contra Costa and Solano Counties.

BUILD HOMES & FINANCIAL STABILITY

Piedmont Church Mission Partner - HABITAT FOR HUMANITY, EAST BAY/ SILICON VALLEY builds strength, stability and self-reliance through affordable homes. Provide a family in the Bay Area with the opportunity for homebuyer and credit counseling, critical home repairs for seniors and those with disabilities, or the opportunity to build and purchase their own affordable home.

HELP FAMILIES IN TRANSITION

Piedmont Church Mission Partner - **GRATEFUL GATHERINGS** is a community-based effort to help families moving from homelessness into a new life. Once they get a place to live, they rarely have anything to put in it. No bed, furniture, kitchen needs, linens or even toys for the kids. With a host of volunteers, we collect what they need, deliver it and set it up, creating a warm, safe, equipped place to call home.

PROVIDE PEDIATRIC PALLIATIVE CARE

Piedmont Church Mission Partner - **GEORGE MARK CHILDREN'S HOUSE**, founded in 2004 and located in San Leandro, is the first pediatric palliative care home in the U.S. George Mark focuses on quality of life and continuity of care for children with illnesses that modern healthcare cannot yet cure, or for those who have chronic medical conditions, in our beautiful homelike setting.

FOSTER SAFETY AND PEACEFUL CONFLICT RESOLUTION

Piedmont Church Mission Partner - **DESTINY ARTS CENTER** inspires and ignites social change through the arts, helping 2,600 Oakland youth annually become peaceful, powerful and creative. At our N. Oakland studios, at school and community partner sites and on stages throughout the Bay Area, Destiny Arts Center teaches mastery of movement arts, conflict resolution and how to be advocates for peace since 1988. Destiny moves at the intersection of the arts, civic engagement and social change.
